The SGO Team provide support to carers, children and young people. They offer a kinship carer support group and access to therapeutic interventions. The team also plan and facilitate seasonal activities and events.



Kinship Carer Support Group

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council have established a support group for all kinship carers alongside The Link CIC and Grandparent's Plus.

The group takes place fortnightly on a Tuesday from 10-12 at Kielder Close Children's Centre.

The group is designed for all kinship carers who are looking after children that cannot be cared for by their own parents. It allows carers to come together and gain information as well as peer support in a safe and friendly environment.
