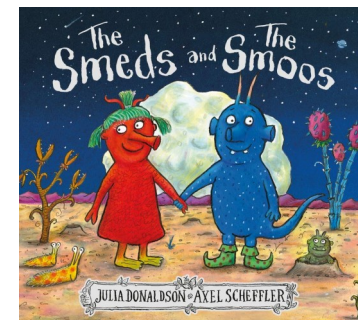
Follow the link and watch the video about

Art—

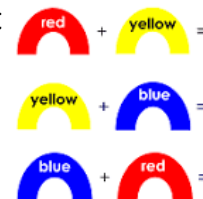


Can you draw any of the aliens mentioned in 'The Smeds and the Smoos'?
