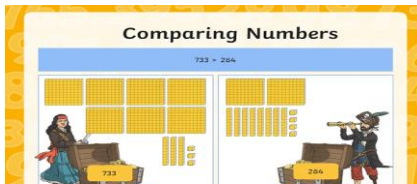


## Year 3 – Learning Document – WB 27<sup>th</sup> April

### English – Daedalus and Icarus



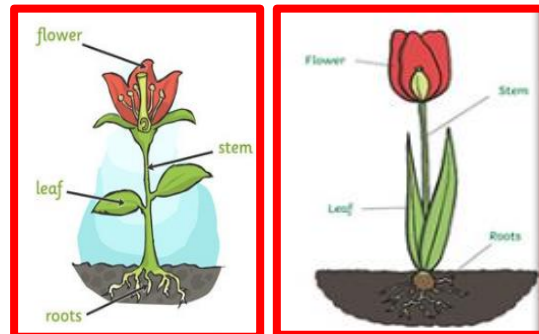
