Phonics—Collect words that include these graphemes. ai, a-e, ay, ey, eigh. Can you make sentences using the words you find? For example:

rainbow. I can see a rainbow.

plane. The plane flew over a rainbow.

Spelling—In your home learning pack you have a list of spellings and key words. Choose five to learn this week using 'look, cover, write and check'.

Try writing each word in lots of rainbow colours then put these words into simple sentences.



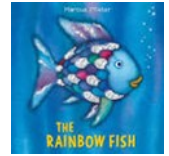
P.E—Daily exercise is really important, choose your favourite song and make up a dance routine to it. Then teach it to your family, get everyone dancing!



Art/Craft—Can you make a 2-D shape mobile? Use empty food packaging to make the shapes. Include a circle, square, rectangle, triangle and diamond. Make it as colourful as you can.



Reading—Enjoy books every day! Use websites and YouTube to listen to stories too! Try watching The Rainbow Fish it is a great story and the pictures are beautiful.



Draw a character from one of your favourite stories, add labels to describe your character for example:

Sharpe pointy teeth, long tongue, pointy ears, big black eyes, hairy grey body, likes to eat pigs. Can you guess which character I am describing?

Writing—At the end of a rainbow there is believed to be a pot of gold. Gold is something special and precious. Think of all the things that you have that are special to you, these might be things like your family, friends, pets, holidays, your first pair of shoes etc.

Write simple sentences to describe what would be in your pot of gold.



Maths—Keep learning your multiplication tables in your purple book. Start counting in multiples forwards and backwards then break it down to learn 6 at a time. You need to be able to know your 10x, 5x and 2x tables.
