Remember to take your time, proof read and edit before sending it back to me.

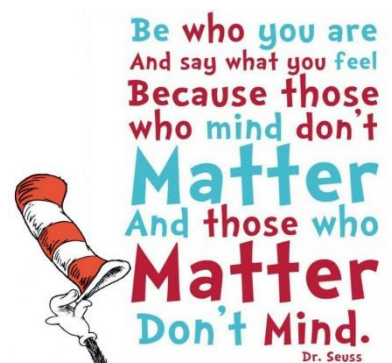
I can't wait to read them all and see how your handwriting is coming on!
