

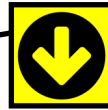
Let's practise our listening and reading skills with *Funnybones* by Janet & Allan Ahlberg! Do you know this story already?

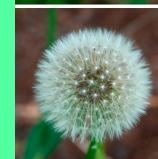


Namaste!
