Step 5 - Make a poster with all this exciting information. It needs to stand out!

3. A school organises a sponsored run for charity. They want to raise £2,600 to help towards building a new library. 124 runners enter the race. Each runner gets sponsored £22. Will this be enough for the school to hit their target?

5. A cyclist went on tour through Italy. He cycled 2688 miles altogether. The ride took him 24 days.

How many miles did he cycle each day?
