Watch the science video about what our teeth are made from and why it's important to brush them.

The enamel on our teeth is similar to that of an egg shell. Carry out the following investigation at home. Please send me pictures!

In your cupboards at home find liquids such as water, milk, juice, fizzy drinks, lemon juice or vinegar.

Pour the exact amount of each liquid into separate glasses.

Ask your adult to crack open an egg as you only need the shell for this investigation. To keep the test fair, use a similar amount of egg shell and drop a piece into each of the liquids. Leave the shell for a day or two then check what has happened. What does the shell feel like? Smell like? What has happened to the colour of the shell? Record your results!

This is what happens to your teeth if you don't brush them and eat sugary or acidic foods. Remember to brush at least twice a day!
