This week I would like you to practise the last family of letters. The 'zigzag monster' letters.



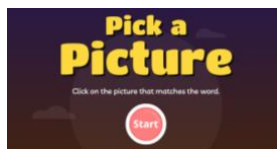
You could use felt tip pens and make some rainbow letters

I wonder if you can find 5 things in your home that will float and 5 things that sink. Before you test them try and predict whether you think they will float or sink. I wonder if you will guess right!

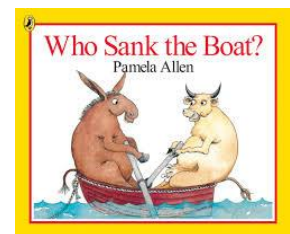
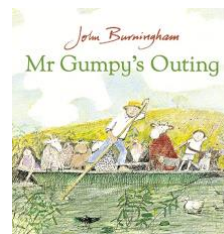

Maths

Have you listened to the story 'Who Sank the Boat?' The boat sank because the animals were too heavy!

Ask your child to be a human balance scale - place an item on each hand and ask them to tip to show which item is heavier and which is lighter.

Give your child an item, for example an apple. Challenge them to find things which feel heavier and lighter than the apple. Sort them into two sets.
