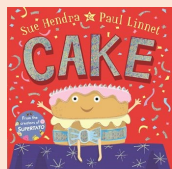


Let's practise our listening and reading skills with a story about a character called Cake who gets invited to a party. It is called *Cake* by Sue Hendra & Paul Linnet!
