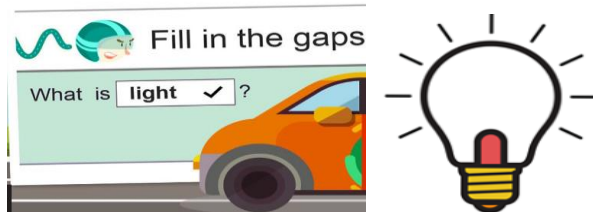


Science
