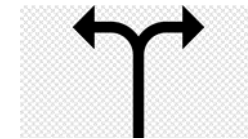
- Stop the video at 0:45. What have you learnt about Dustin from this first part of the film? What do you think will happen next?

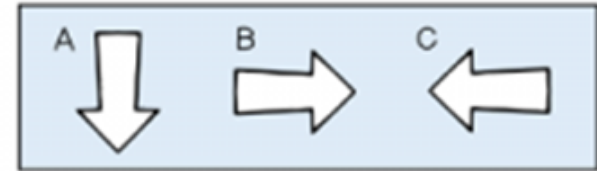
